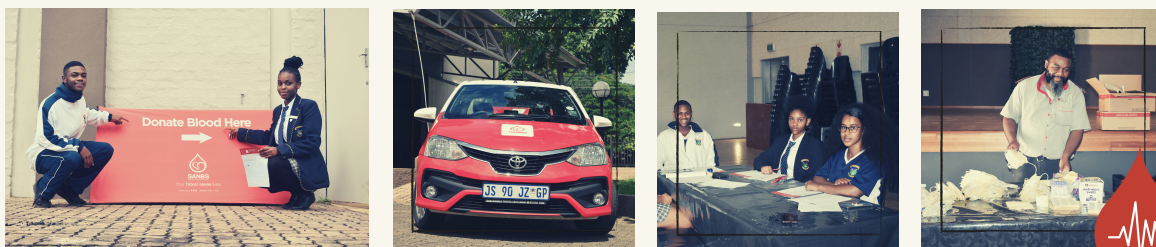
VALENTINE'S DAY

FIELD TRIPS

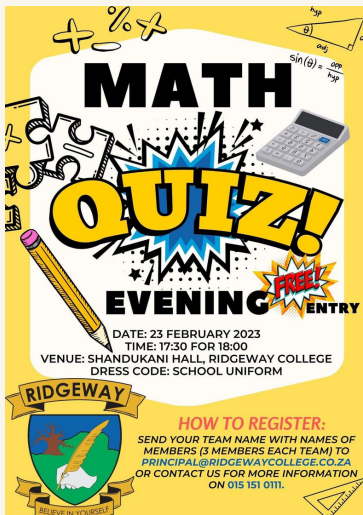

Please note: Monday 20 February is a normal school day for Grade 8-10 pupils.

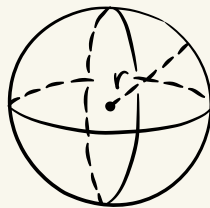
We wish our children and staff safe travels and we will be updating our parents periodically via the D6 App during the course of their trip.
