You will notice that the Homework Club as well as Intervention sessions are on the Extramural Program. Please note that the Academic Aspects of the program do take precedence over sport/cultural items

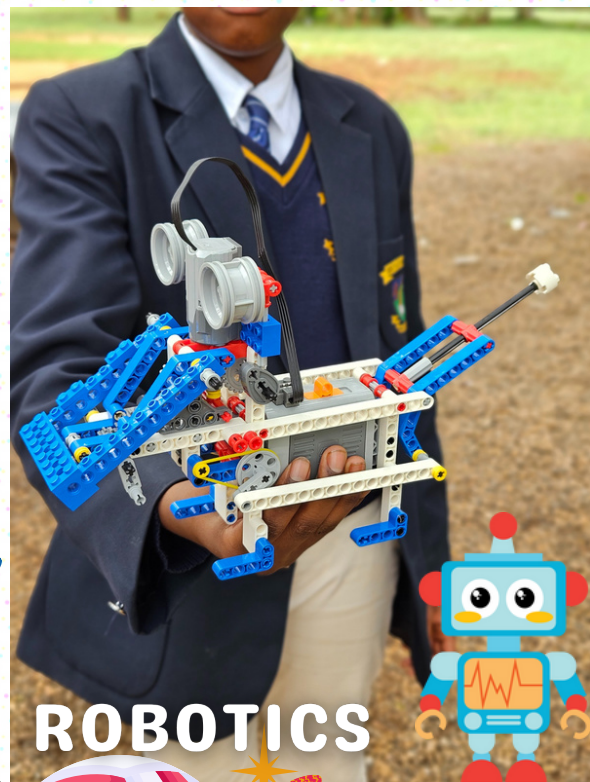
